When I Arrive



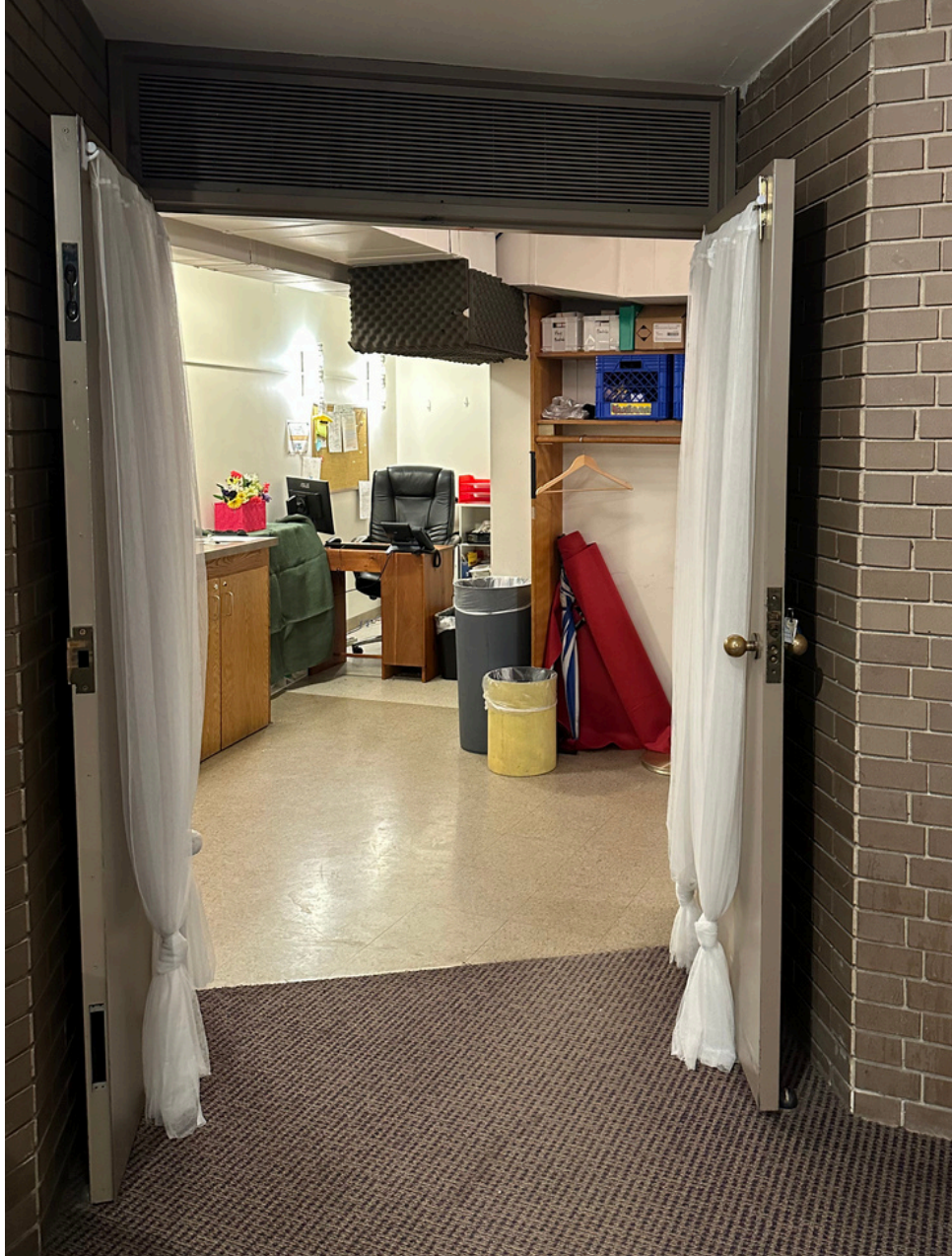
When I arrive, I will wait in line to enter with my family or group. It may be loud and crowded, but I can wear my headphones if I need to.

The Todd Wehr Theater is considered a headphone zone as there can be loud sounds in the lobby and during the show.

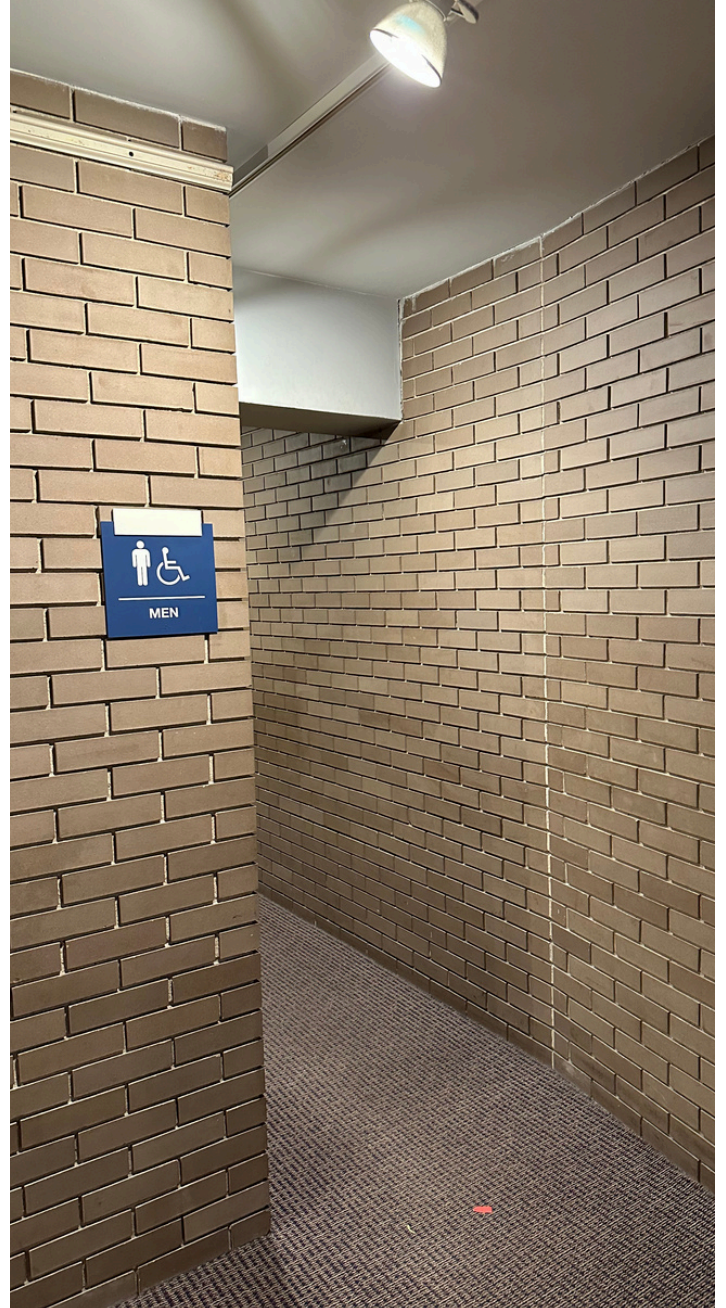
I might feel most comfortable wearing my headphones while I'm visiting.
